

## Years 7 -10

All below costs except uniform and sundry items can be paid upfront or divided into weekly or fortnightly payments and added to your school fees account.

*Textbook & stationery costs vary depending on participation in the BYOD program.*

Bring Your Own Device refers to student-owned laptop/tablet.

The advantages of this program can include significantly reduced stationery costs, reduced textbook costs, increased flexibility and access to more resources as well as the added security option of internet filtering at home.

Because we believe there is significant educational advantage to having a device, we would encourage students and parents to consider this, however, there is no requirement for parents to purchase any device.

### BYOD

All of these recommended devices are able to be used like traditional note books. These devices can also be written on with a special pen and used instead of biros and books. This means no more lost or torn notes or assignments, quick and easy note taking, and heavy textbooks are a thing of the past.

Other devices are accepted, however the minimum specifications are:

No android devices – they will not work on our network, minimum i5 or equivalent processor. Choosing an i3 or less powerful CPU equivalent means that the device may not have the longevity to complete school.

Bringing a device other than the recommended will require stationary items to be purchased.

### STATIONERY & CONSUMABLES

For simplicity, the textbook hire scheme and stationery costs have been combined into a single line item. This is the total cost for all stationary for your student for the whole year, technologies and all ICT costs for the year.

Any additional **stationary items** required throughout the year will be supplied **free** through the uniform shop

If you wish to purchase the *stationery* elsewhere, please let us know and we will provide a stationary list and deduct these from the total.

Sundry items needing replacing throughout the year may be repurchased from the uniform shop.

Lost or damaged textbooks will incur full replacement cost.
